During the Public Portion of any meeting, the members of the Public as well as the Governing Body shall be courteous and respectful to one another. No comments and/or behavior that are considered disrespectful, ill-willed or with the intent to harass will be tolerated. If such behavior occurs, then that individual member of the Public will be asked to sit down and his or her turn to speak will be over, even if the five minutes is not.

#### John Daly, 11 York Drive.

Mr. Daly stated that when it rains there is a big puddle in front of the port-a-john at the Maple Street Park and inquired if the Borough can put down stones. The Mayor stated that we will speak to the Director of the DPW. Mr. Daly asked if there is an ordinance for shoveling your sidewalk after a snowstorm, the Mayor stated that there is.

#### Rocco DeSantis, 14 George W Helme Drive.

Mr. DeSantis stated that on Monday morning during the recycling pick up because it was so windy many residents in the Regency Walk community had their recycling blown all over the road. He inquired if there is a way for the recycling company to come back. The Mayor gave him a number to contact the recycling company. Mr. DeSantis stated that the recycling company also came at 6:00am and many residents did not have it out yet. Council President Karczewski stated that there is an ordinance that no large trucks are to come through town until 7:00am. Business Administrator Crane will let the Director of the DPW know as he will contact the recycling company. Mr. DeSantis inquired about the potholes on High Street and Main Street. The Mayor stated that we will look into it because it may be Conrail's property. Business Administrator Crane will let the Director of the DPW know. Mr. DeSantis stated that over the past few weekends on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings they have seen many young kids in the Regency Walk community. They are ringing doorbells and then running away and knocking on windows. By the time they call the police, and they arrive, the kids are already gone. Council President Karczewski will contact the Chief of police to inquire about proactively patrol the area.

#### Yvonna Dzietczyk, owner of 4 Main Street.

She stated that her husband has been in the hospital, and they are aware there have been complaints about them not shoveling in front of their business. She apologized and said it will be taken care of in the future. The contractor that was shoveling for them is no longer renting space in their building. She stated that the neighbors that complain about their business are

constantly watching them. She stated that she knows that Tony is the one making the complaints and that's because he wants to buy their property. She stated that they invested in the property and many Helmetta residents are their tenants. She feels that she is following the rules and does not know why she is constantly being watched. She stated that whenever there is a complaint the Code Enforcer comes out and gives them a violation and then they have to go to court. She would like to meet with the Code Enforcer and the Mayor. She stated that the neighbors that are complaining about the noise should have known when they moved in that they were going to be close to a commercial business. She stated it is not a residential zone; it is a commercial zone. She stated it is like moving next to the train tracks and then complaining that you hear a train. She feels that Tony is harassing her and constantly contacting her lawyer. The Mayor advised her to have her attorney reach out to the Borough attorney, that he cannot discuss anything further since litigation was threatened against the Borough.

\* REPORTS of Committees, Business Administrator

Councilman Dzingleski spoke on upcoming events in the Borough including International Women's Day on March 8<sup>th</sup>, Lucky Leprechaun Leap on March 17<sup>th</sup>, Dunk with the DPW on March 20<sup>th</sup>, and the Rabies Clinic on March 25<sup>th</sup>.

Councilman Reid thanked everyone that came out for the Pizza and Pop with a Cop and the Service and Sweets Valentine's Day card creations for Veterans and our troops.

Council President Karczewski stated that he did not have a public safety meeting but has been in contact with the Chief over any issues or concerns in the Borough.

Councilman Duffy read a statement from Paul Reed, Director of Public Works that stated: Winter weather has been ongoing, and we have been dealing with it accordingly. No issues to report. Gazebo for Maple Street Park is in the works. Waiting to hear from the contractor for the prep work schedule. Looking forward to having this completed by early Spring. Waiting to hear back from North American Pipe for a jetting of the sanitary line on Lake Ave. to clear a partial blockage that was noticed during sanitary inspections. AT&T has a contractor working on their equipment at the tower and work should be completed in the next week or two, pending the weather. A more permanent removable set up for the pavilion lot bistro lighting is in the work for our events. Routine work is ongoing. I would also like to add the importance of the Community Center roof being redone as it is crucial to the structure's integrity. We need to spackle and paint the walls and ceiling, however with the roof in the condition it is currently in that would only be a band aid and quite frankly a waste of money.

Councilwoman Bohinski stated that the Board of Education is continuing their search for a Superintendent.

Mayor Slavicek would like to thank the DPW for all of their hard work with the snowstorms and inclement weather. He hosted a Sweet Staff appreciation on Valentine's Day and provided lunch for all the hard-working employees of the Borough. He will once again be participating in Read Across America Day in the school district.

Business Administrator Matthew Crane stated that he and Melissa Hallerman completed the Recreation grant and we are awaiting to hear back on it.

Municipal Clerk Melissa Hallerman stated that the County will be hosting a fraud prevention seminar in March, all are welcome to attend. More information is on our website. Planning has started for 2025 Spark in the Park, save the date of July 3<sup>rd</sup>. Planning has also begun for Elections of 2025, as it is anticipated to have a large turnout for both Primary and General as it is an election for New Jersey Governor.



- WHEREAS, Heather Glen Condominium Association (the "Association") is a qualified private community pursuant to Chapter 299, Public Law 1989, as amended (the "Law"); and
- **WHEREAS**, the Borough of Helmetta is required to provide to reimburse the Association for certain municipal services pursuant to the Law; and
- WHEREAS, if the Borough provides reimbursement to the Association for certain municipal services, the reimbursement shall not exceed the amount that the Borough would have expended to provide the equivalent services; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Borough and the Association entered into an Agreement dated June 23, 1994 providing for the reimbursement procedure for covered municipal services; and
- WHEREAS, RCP Management Company, on behalf of the Association, submitted bills from Interstate Waste Services, Inc. for garbage and recycling services for the year 2024 in the amount of \$69,756.87, which represents garbage and recycling pickup at twice the frequency of the Borough pickup; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer has determined that the cost that would have been paid by the Association if they had the same level of service provided by the Borough to be \$93,497.75; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer has determined that, under the Borough's agreements in place for 2024, it would have cost the Borough approximately \$ 34,878.44 to provide equivalent services; and
- WHEREAS, RCP Management Company, on behalf of the Association, submitted bills from Jersey Central Power & Light for street lighting for the year 2024 in the amount of \$5,941.36 and
- **WHEREAS**, the Borough is responsible for forty percent (40%) of the street lighting bill as certain of the lights illuminate private parking areas.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Helmetta that the Chief Financial Officer be and is hereby authorized to issue a check in the amount of thirty eight thousand right hundred forty dollars and seventy-nine cents (\$ 38,040.79) to Heather Glen Condominium Association representing 2024 garbage reimbursement of thirty-four thousand eight hundred seventy-eight dollars and forty-four cents (\$ 34,878.44) and 2024 street light reimbursement of three thousand one hundred sixty-four dollars and thirty-five cents (\$ 3,162.35).
